2. As per the student feedback, college is trying to increase student participation in sports and curricular activities.

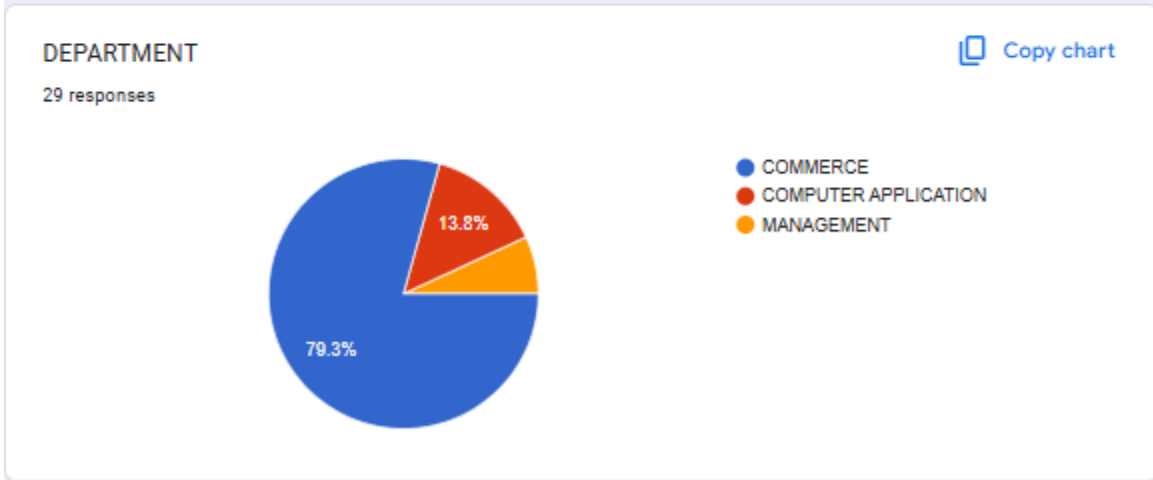
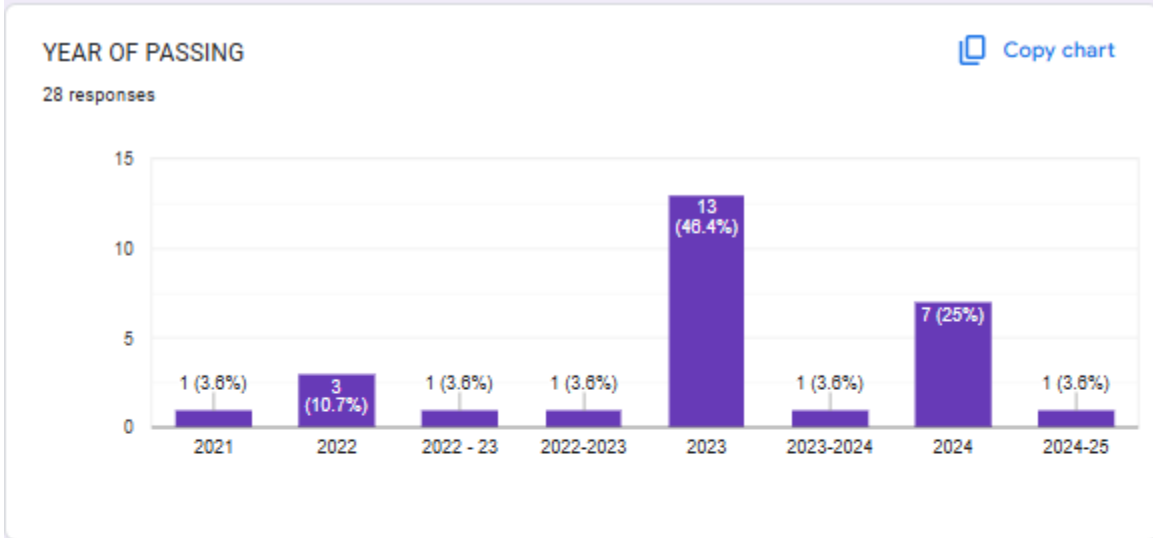


The minutes of the previous meeting were read out by Dr Ashish Dubey (secretary of council) and it is need by confirmed.


Agenda 2-
